

Widow's Pension Claim

One Thousand Nine Hundred and *nine*, personally appeared before me, a *Notary Public* in and for the County and State aforesaid, *Nancy Bryant* a resident of *Palmyra* County of *Manatee* State of Florida, who being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain a pension under the provisions of Chapter 5885, Laws of Florida, approved June 7, 1909.

That she is the widow of *Charley Bryant* who was enlisted under the name of *Charley Bryant* on the *don't remember* day of *186*, in Company *Coachman* *Company* Regiment of the State of *Georgia* and who was honorably discharged ~~at~~ *came home sick with the measles*, 186, on account of *about the close of the war*
